1. 分数计算:本题总分 20 分,采用分项评分方式,其中内容 8 分,语言 8 分,结构 4 分。

具体计算方法:总分(20 分) = 内容(8 分)×1 + 语言(8 分)×1 + 结构(8 分)×0.5。

2. 评分时先判断作答内容与题目是否有关,若内容判为零分,语言与结构均为零分。

3. 英式、美式拼写均可接受。
