【答案解析】

21. D 根据题干中的关键词“Sawdust Winter Fantasy”定位至第一部分,由其中的“Price: Adults \$ 10 Children \$ 5”可知,如果一对夫妻带两个小孩选择了该项目,需要支付30美元。故选D项。
22. B 根据 LA County Parks Winter Wonderland 部分中的“The free event will feature photo... decorate their own stockings.”及“Location: 1324 5th St. in Downtown Santa Monica”可知,孩子们可以在 1324 5th St. in Downtown Santa Monica 装饰他们的长袜。故选B项。
23. C 根据 Christmas on the Farm 部分中的“There’s also a holiday train and plenty of sleigh rides to go around.”可知,在这个项目中,人们可以坐雪橇,其时间为 Dates: Nov. 25 to Dec. 24,由此可知,12月20这个时间是合适的,故选C项。

24 - 27 CBBA

【答案解析】

24. C 根据文章第一段“... has recently gone viral for its ‘Village Super League’.”以及第三段中的“This is a soccer carnival...”可知榕江的乡村超级足球联赛吸引了大量的观众前来观看。故选C项。
25. B 根据文章第四段“In the county, rural soccer matches have taken place regularly since the 1990s...”可知自20世纪90年代以来,该县定期举办乡村足球比赛。当缺乏设施时,足球运动员们用贫瘠的土地作为场地,用木桩作为柱子。用石灰粉划出边界。当他们无法召集足够的球员时,他们会玩五人制足球,这是一种在较小的硬地球场上进行的足球比赛。故选B项。
26. B 根据文章第五段“What sets the Village Super League apart from other sports events are the vibrant displays of ethnic cultures and traditions at the tournament.”和第六段“I hope that more and more tourists will come to Rongjiang to watch the matches, enjoy the folk customs and local cuisine, and have fun,”可知。故选B项。
27. A 根据第六段中的数据可知乡村足球联赛促进了本地经济增长。故选A项。

28 - 31 DDAC

【答案解析】

28. D 根据画线词上下文内容可知,Lolita——迈阿密水族馆的明星虎鲸,在被捕获并关在迈阿密水族馆50多年后,终于能够回到太平洋西北部的家乡水域度过余生。结合选项可推知,画线词所在句应表示Lolita终于能够“告别”佛罗里达州的小水箱。“say goodbye to”意为“告别”,符合语境,故选D项。
29. D 根据第二段中的“Lolita, also known as Tokitae or Toki, is a 57-year-old female orca”及“Lolita has lived at Miami Seaquarium since 1970, after she was captured from the waters of Puget Sound at 4 years old.”可知,Lolita是一只57岁的雌性虎鲸。1970年,年仅4岁的Lolita在普吉特海湾水域被捕获,此后一直生活在迈阿密水族馆里。由此可推知,Lolita在迈阿密水族馆里生活了50多年。故选D项。
30. A 根据第三段内容可知,水族馆宣布在未来两年内开始将Lolita送回自然栖息地。然而,Lolita已经衰老,她被囚禁了几十年,无法自己找到食物,这些都可能使她重返野外的过程变得复杂。环境历史学家Mr. Colby表示,在一项长达两年的计划中,Lolita将首先被飞机运送到华盛顿州和加拿大之间水域的海洋保护区,在那里训练员会教她在安全网内捕鱼。此外她还需要锻炼肌肉,因为虎鲸通常每天要游160公里左右。由此可知,Lolita将会接受在海域里生活的训练。故选A项。
31. C 本文主要介绍了虎鲸Lolita,自1970年被人类捕获后,被圈养在迈阿密水族馆生活了五十几年,水族馆近日准备将其释放,让其返回海洋生活的故事,同时介绍了Lolita的安置与放生计划。结合选项,C项可以概括此内容,故选C项。

32-35 CBAC

【答案解析】

32. C 根据第二段内容可知,阿姆斯特丹的街道上到处是塌陷坑,1700 座桥梁中有近一半的桥不稳固,需要维修。最根本的问题是运河边城墙的状况:大约 125 英里的建筑墙面破损严重,有坍塌入运河的风险,可能会造成建筑物受损和人员伤亡。随着一项加固运河城墙的大型工程的进行,这座城市开始看起来像一个巨大的建筑工地。由此可知,阿姆斯特丹面临的问题是运河城墙有坍塌的风险。故选 C 项。
33. B 根据第三段内容可知,像荷兰的大部分地区一样,阿姆斯特丹位于海平面以下。这座城市建在一片沼泽上,在 17 世纪进行了大规模扩建,将数以百万计的木桩用作地基。随着现代生活改变了城市,许多房屋用水泥和混凝土加固,但街道和运河墙的地基却被忽视了。许多木桩在压力下移位、开裂或倒塌,导致桥梁和运河侧壁下沉和开裂,然后水渗进来,冲走木桩大坝下的砂浆,进一步掏空地下的基础建设,形成塌陷坑。由此可知,第三段主要解释了阿姆斯特丹地面塌陷坑的成因。故选 B 项。
34. A 根据第四段中的“The reconstruction will take... Mr. De Vries said.”可知,重建工作至少需要 20 年,耗资 20 亿欧元,甚至更多。Mr. De Vries 表示这是一个很庞大的数字,并且这些工作需要在一个非常繁忙、人口密集的地区进行。由此可知,Mr. De Vries 认为重建工作的代价很高。故选 A 项。
35. C 根据最后一段内容可知,Mr. De Vries 承认,未来几年的阿姆斯特丹看上去将不同于明信片上的阿姆斯特丹。不过,他坚持认为不应该阻止游客参观。他表示希望邀请大家来看看他们在做什么。他们想让游客意识到,如此宏伟的城市需要维护。由此可推知,Mr. De Vries 认为城市的维修工作与旅游业应同时开展。故选 C 项。
