My simple life consisted of books, a cat, and a glass of drink every evening. Occasional dinners with friends kept me from being a total shut-in. But a sense of unease settled over me. My mother used to say, "You don't regret what you did but what you didn't do." Honoring her philosophy, I wouldn't let fear win.

I couldn't remember the last time I had done something just for myself. I needed to set personal boundaries. So I grabbed my laptop and began researching tours. A couple of clicks and glasses of drink later, I booked a tour. In a few months, I would fly to Greece all by myself.

The night before my big adventure, "what-ifs" crowded into my brain. All my friends and family were impressed with my bravery. Off I went excitedly with my suitcase. We flew across the Atlantic on a huge plane packed with vacationing families and senior citizens. After a long, sleepless flight, I stepped off the plane into the airport. Foreign languages filled my ears, but that couldn't diminish my initial feeling. I was as excited as I set out. My Greek adventure began.

Volunteering is one of the best ways for the elderly to get involved in their local communities, share a lifetime of experiences, develop new relationships, and help make the world a little bit better.

There are many good reasons to volunteer, and it's important to understand that many of them involve meeting the older people's needs. “That's not being selfish,” says Tema Fishbein, director of external affairs for Experience Corp., a school mentoring nonprofit that places older people in schools in 22 communities around the country. “Most people do selfless things for personal reasons, and that's not necessarily bad,” she says. Among the motives she sees in volunteers are a desire to give back to the community, to improve one's own life and health, to meet new peers (同龄人) and expand one's social network, and to give purpose and meaning to life.

Will you be good at it? People who've functioned well in the home and workplace have picked up the skills needed to be productive volunteers. Life experiences count as much here as book smarts. Most volunteer work is people-intensive, so the ability to work well with others is particularly useful. “Someone who has a good work ethic (职业道德) or commitment to what they want to do makes for a good volunteer,” Fishbein says. “They also need flexibility so they can fit themselves into an organization. And they all need empathy—the ability to put themselves in someone else's shoes.”

Volunteers spend different amounts of time in their work, but the best matches are those where supply and demand are balanced. Do you want to make a commitment to tutor a young student, such as building a close relationship that may extend over several years? Or are you more interested in single-shot opportunities that might engage you for a few weeks or months? You can find them all. “We want our volunteers to be renewable and to work with us for a number of years,” says Fishbein.

China, whose astronauts have long been deliberately prevented from the ISS (国际空间站), successfully launched the first core module (核心舱) of its planned space station on Thursday morning from the Wenchang launch site in the southern island of Hainan. The module, currently the largest spacecraft developed by China, was launched into low earth orbit by a Long March 5B rocket, marking the first step of China's efforts to build its own station in two years. The space station won't launch all at once; it will be assembled from several modules launching at different times and will be fully operational by the end of 2022.

The core module has a length of 16.6 meters and a living space of 50 cubic meters. It's expected to operate for 10 to 15 years. Eleven launches are scheduled in the next two years. The first manned mission was launched in June of this year—sending three astronauts to orbit for about three months, during which the life support system and maintenance would be tested.

It won't be as large as the ISS—about one fifth of its size and similar to the Russian Mir space station, which operated from 1986 to 2001. China launched its first manned space flight in 2003—more than 40 years after NASA. But as the nation has grown richer and more powerful in recent decades, its space program has sped up.

China's space station—the core module is known as Tianhe, which means harmony of the heavens—will conduct a number of scientific experiments. Six projects have been fully accepted so far including one on the possible effects of spaceflight on cancer tumors (肿瘤) conducted by researchers from Norway, the Netherlands, Belgium and France. "International cooperation helps China's scientific community to learn from other nations and describe China

第四档(10—12):完全完成了试题规定的任务,达到了预期的写作目的。

——虽漏掉一两个次重点,但覆盖所有主要内容。

——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

——语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。

——应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑。

第三档(7—9):基本完成了试题规定的任务,整体而言,基本达到了预期的写作目的。

——虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖所有主要内容。

——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

——有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,但不影响理解。

——应用简单的语句间的连接成分,使全文内容连贯。

第二档(4—6):未恰当完成试题规定的任务,信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

——漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容,写了一些无关内容。

——语法结构单调,词汇项目有限。

——有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响了对写作内容的理解。

——较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性。

第一档(1—3):未完成试题规定的任务,信息未能传达给读者。

——明显遗漏主要内容,写了一些无关内容,原因可能是未理解试题要求。

——语法结构单调,词汇项目有限。

——较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响对写作内容的理解。

——缺乏语句间的连接成分,内容不连贯。

不得分(0):未能传达给读者任何信息。内容太少,无法评判;写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。

——与所给短文融洽度较高,与所提供各段落开头语衔接较为合理。

——内容比较丰富。

——所使用语法结构和词汇较为丰富、准确,可能有些许错误,但不影响意义表达。

——比较有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使所续写的短文结构紧凑。

第三档(11—15)

——与所给短文关系较为密切,与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接。

——写出了若干有关内容。

——应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求,虽有一些错误,但不影响意义表达。

——应用简单的语句间连接成分,使全文内容连贯。

第二档(6—10)

——与所给短文有一定的关系,与所提供各段落开头语有一定程度的衔接。

——写出了一些有关内容。

——语法结构单调,词汇项目有限,有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误,影响了意义的表达。

——较少使用语句间的连接成分,全文内容缺少连贯性。

第一档(1—5)

——与所提供短文和开头语的衔接较差。

——产出内容较少。

——语法结构单调,词汇项目很有限,有较多语法结构和词汇方面的错误,严重影响了意义的表达。

——缺乏语句间的连接成分,全文内容不连贯。
